

ORDINANCE NO. 635

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING CERTAIN STATUTES OF THE STATE OF INDIANA RELATING TO THE CREATION OF A SANITARY DISTRICT IN CITIES OF THE FIRST CLASS SO AS TO MAKE THEM APPLICABLE TO THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has constructed and now operates a sanitary sewer system consisting of collector sewers, interceptor sewers, lift stations and transmission lines which provide for the collection and transportation of sanitary sewage and wastewater to the Town of Schererville, Lake County, Indiana, for purposes of treatment; and

WHEREAS, certain sections of said sanitary sewer have failed or are in need of repair, need to be completed, or need to be designed and installed; and

WHEREAS, in order to promptly complete, install, repair and design existing facilities and new facilities it is necessary to promptly provide additional financing and funds; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to create a department of the Town of St. John exclusively charged with the responsibility of overseeing and controlling the sanitary sewage system of the Town of St. John, Lake County Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the creation of a sanitary sewer district will provide for additional flexibility, control, and funding for needed repairs, completions and installations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, as follows:

Section 1. Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the

Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, that Indiana Code, Title 36, Article 9, Chapter 25, as amended and supplemented be and is hereby adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, so as to make said acts and all amendments and supplements thereto effective and operative as to the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, provided, however:

A. The Board of Sanitary Commissioners shall consist of three (3) members, provided however, that not more than two (2) of the commissioners may be of the same political party.

B. One member of such Board of Sanitary Commissioners to be appointed by the President of the Board of Trustees of the Town shall serve for a term of three (3) years from the first day of January, 1984.

C. One member of such Board of Sanitary Commissioners to be appointed by the President of the Board of Trustees of the Town shall serve for a term of two (2) years from the first day of January, 1984.

D. One member of such Board of Sanitary Commissioners to be appointed by the President of the Board of Trustees of the Town shall serve for a term of one (1) year from the first day of January, 1984.

E. As the initial term of the Commissioner expires, successors shall be appointed for four (4) year terms.

F. The members of such Board of Sanitary Commissioners of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, shall hold a meeting for the purpose of organization not later than six (6) months after the date of the adoption of this Ordinance.


G. The first report of such Board to the President of the Board of Trustees of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, shall cover the period from the date of organization of such Board to the first day of January, 1985.


H. The powers herein granted to such Board of Sanitary Commissioners of such Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, shall be cumulative to the powers now granted by any other law to them or either of them.


Section 2. Indiana Acts 1969, Chapter 248, and all of the rights, privileges and obligations pertaining thereunder is and are hereby adopted by the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, and the Board of Trustees of said Town.

Section 3. Whereas, an emergency exists for the immediate taking effect of this Ordinance, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.


