

ORDINANCE NO. 667

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS  
OF THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, does now find that an emergency exists and that in order to provide for the payment of certain bills, it is necessary to transfer funds from the Police Department and General Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees on December 27, 1984, did pass Ordinance 656, an ordinance amending Ordinance 623 and all amendments thereto, being an "Ordinance Establishing A Schedule Of Wages And Salaries For The Town Of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, For Town Employees, Fire and Police Personnel, And Town Officials"; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance provided for the payment of the sum of \$26,335.00 per year for a Police Lieutenant and the sum of \$22,105.00 per year for a First Class Patrolman; and

WHEREAS, the department has employed an additional First Class Patrolman rather than a Police Lieutenant, and there exists a surplus in the Police Department Fund, Appropriation No. 102, designated "Police Officers", therefore, in the sum of \$4,230.00; and

WHEREAS, in the budget estimate for the St. John Police Department approved on August 27, 1984, at Appropriation No. 105, designated "Performance Incentive", there was budgeted for the St. John Police Department the sum of \$3,000.00; and

WHEREAS, said \$3,000.00 sum has proven inadequate and insufficient in order to pay the bills and implement the Performance Incentive Program set forth by the Police Department of the Town of St. John and approved and administered by the Police Commission of the Town of St. John; and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists requiring the transfer of the

aforesaid \$4,230.00 surplus from Appropriation No. 102, the same being Police Officers' salaries, to the Performance Incentive Fund, the same being Appropriation No. 105, for distribution to the St. John Police Department personnel for the Performance Incentive Program accordingly; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Board of Trustees by this ordinance to authorize the Police Commission to direct the payment of the additional \$4,230.00 to the officers so designated by the Police Chief pursuant to the Performance Incentive Program of the Town of St. John; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, that an emergency exists and in order to provide for the payment of certain bills that a transfer of funds be made as follows, to-wit:

The sum of \$4,230.00 from the Police Department Fund for payment of Police Department salaries and designated Appropriation No. 102, to the Police Department Fund, Appropriation No. 105 for Performance Incentive.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Police Commission is hereby authorized to direct the Clerk-Treasurer to pay such sums to the designated police officers and/or police department personnel pursuant to the Performance Incentive Program established by the St. John Police Department and Police Commission accordingly; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Clerk-Treasurer make appropriate entries on the books of record and account of said accounts to indicate said transfers and forward said entry of the transfers and authorization of these proceeds to the Lake County Auditor and State Board of Accounts for their approval; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that an emergency exists for the immediate taking effect of this Ordinance and there being unanimous consent of the members of the Board of Trustees present, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and adoption by the Board of Trustees and the affixing of their signatures hereto.
