ORDINANCE NO. 686

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PUBLIC STREET IN THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA.

WHEREAS, Petition has been filed to vacate a public street in the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, Public Hearing has been held on the Petition for Vacation of a public street in the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, pursuant to law; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, deems it advisable, necessary, and in the best interests of the Town of St. John, and its residents, to vacate a public street in the Town of St. John, namely, part of Austgen Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, that:

Section One: That part of Austgen Road, a public street right-of-way, which part of said Austgen Road is more particularly described as follows:

The East 25 ft of Austgen Road lying West and adjacent to Lot 26 in Block 1 in Calumet Farms
No. 4, as per plat thereof, recorded in Plat Book 24, page 33, in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana

is hereby and shall be vacated to William Tobias, Jr., and Annette L. Tobias, Husband and Wife, as described herein.

Section Two: That the Clerk-Treasurer of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, is required and shall furnish a copy of the within Vacation Ordinance to the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana, for recording, and to the Auditor of Lake County, Indiana.

Section Three: If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not effect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance.

Section Four: That any provision stated elsewhere which are inconsistent with the terms and provisions of this Ordinance are deemed null and void.
