BEING A JOINT ORDINANCE
OF THE ST. JOHN WATERWORKS DISTRICT
AND TOWN OF ST. JOHN MODIFYING
AND AMENDING ITS SCHEDULE OF RATES
AND CHARGES FOR THE USE OF THE WATERWORKS
OF THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN AND REPEALING
ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH

WHEREAS, the Town of St. John last amended its schedule of rates and charges for the use of the waterworks of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana on January 26, 1977; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of and amendments to certain building codes promulgated by the administrative building counsel of the State of Indiana now require the use of one inch service lines; and

WHEREAS, inflation has increased the cost of materials and services used in the connection to the Town's municipal water system.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY the directors of the Waterworks District of the Town of St. John, Indiana and the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana as follows:

1. That the schedule of rates and charges for the use of the waterworks of the Town of St. John be and is hereby amended in accordance with the schedule attached hereto, made a part hereof and marked as Exhibit "A".

2. That the Clerk/Treasurer of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana published notice of a public hearing to be held on January 18, 1990 at 7:30 o'clock p.m. in the Town Hall in the Town of St. John, Indiana for the purpose of hearing remonstrances to the proposed schedule of rates and charges and that all persons desiring to be heard have been given an opportunity to remonstrate to such schedule.

3. That the schedule of rates and charges attached as Exhibit

"A" be and is hereby approved and adopted and shall be forwarded to the Utility Regulatory Commission of the State of Indiana for its approval as may be required by law.

SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES

WATERWORKS

TOWN OF ST. JOHN

For use of and service rendered by the waterworks system of the Town, based on the use of water supplied by said waterworks system:

(a) <u>Metered Rates Per Month</u>	<u>Rate Per 1,000 Gallons</u>
First 2,500 gallons	\$ 2.32
Next 3,000 gallons	2.14
Next 4,000 gallons	1.79
Next 5,000 gallons	1.43
Over 14,500 gallons	1.07

(b) Minimum Charge Per Month

Each user shall pay a minimum charge in accordance with the following applicable size of meter installed for which the user will be entitled to the quantity of water set out in the above schedule of rates:

<u>Size of Meter</u>	<u>Rate Per Month</u>
3/4 inch meter ¹	\$ 5.80
1 inch meter	8.00
1-1/2 inch meter	14.00
2 inch meter	21.00
3 inch meter	36.00
4 inch meter	90.00
6 inch meter	180.00

(c) <u>Fire Protection Service</u>	<u>Per Annum</u>
Municipal hydrant - per hydrant	\$ 225.00
Private hydrant - per hydrant	225.00

(d) Temporary Users

Water furnished to temporary users, such as contractors, etc., shall be charged on the basis of the metered rates

¹ All service lines for 3/4 inch meters shall be not less than one inch corporation stop, shut off and supply line.
