

ORDINANCE NO. 877

THE SAME BEING AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 764 AND 774, AND MODIFYING THE PROVISIONS OF THE SAME WITH REGARD TO BUSINESS LICENSES IN THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA.

WHEREAS, the legislative body of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, did pass on November 14, 1988, Ordinance No. 764, the same being an Ordinance establishing an annual fee and requiring a license for the operation of a business or commercial establishment within the Town limits of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the legislative body of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, did amend said Ordinance on January 9, 1989, by passing Ordinance No. 774, the same being an Ordinance exempting non-profit organizations from the fee charged for such a license but still requiring a license; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, that it would be beneficial to again amend said Ordinance to require a business that moves or relocates to another location within the Town limits of the Town, that such business, within ten (10) days of such relocation, and preferably prior to such relocation, advise the Town Clerk-Treasurer of the same so that the information required on the business license application can be updated and corrected accordingly; and

WHEREAS, it is therefore the intention of the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, to accordingly amend Ordinance No. 764 and 774, aforesaid; and that it is in the best interests of the residents of the Town of St. John to do so.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that a new Section 11 shall be added, be designated "Relocation", and shall therefore read as follows:


"Any person, firm, partnership, corporation, association, agent, or the like, required to obtain a business license in the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, shall, when said business changes its location or relocates within the Town limits of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, shall, within ten (10) days of such relocation, and preferably sooner, update its information required on the application for business license. There shall be no additional fee charged for updating said information."


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all other Ordinances and Resolutions of the Town of St. John that are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of any such conflict; however, notwithstanding the foregoing, all other Ordinances and Resolutions not in conflict herewith shall remain in full force and effect; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that an emergency exists for the immediate taking effect of this Ordinance, and the same shall take effect immediately upon its passage by the Town Council and posting as required by law.
