

ORDINANCE #878

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR DEPARTMENTS OF THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, INDIANA, FOR THE YEAR 1991, AS REQUESTED BY THE DEPARTMENT HEADS AND FORWARDED TO THE TOWN COUNCIL FOR THEIR ACTION AND PASSAGE PURSUANT TO IC 6-1.1-18-6


WHEREAS, certain extraordinary conditions have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget for the year 1991 and it is now necessary to transfer appropriations into different categories than was appropriated in the annual budget for the various functions of the departments to meet the emergencies.


SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, INDIANA, that for the expenses of the Town Government, the following appropriations are hereby transferred and set apart out of the funds hereinafter named for the purposes specified, subject to the laws governing the same, such sums herein transferred unless otherwise stipulated by law.


SECTION 2. Where it has been shown that certain existing appropriations have unobligated balances which will be available for transferring as follows:


