ordinance no. 32-33

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BEING A JOINT ORDINANCE OF THE ST. JOHN SANITARY DISTRICT OF THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN AND THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 635 OF THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE, COUNTY, INDIANA AND PROVIDING FOR THE ALLOCATION OF FUNDS BETWEEN SUCH DISTRICT AND THE SEWER UTILITY OF THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN

WHEREAS, the Town of St. John operates a municipal sewer utility through the Sanitary District of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, funds of the St. John Municipal Sewer Utility remain within the jurisdiction and authority of the Town Council of the Town of St. John; and

WHEREAS, the Sanitary District of the Town of St. John maintains an operating budget and levy appropriating monies raised by taxation within the Town of St. John; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to establish the order of priority and payment for various claims made against the Municipal Sewer Utility and Sanitary District

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Sanitary District of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana and the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana:

Section 1. That to the extent funds are available within the operating budget and tax levy established by the Sanitary District of the Town of St. John, all claims submitted for materials, services, and/or labor, which may be charged to any line item within such budget, shall be paid first from the funds appropriated by the Sanitary District of the Town of St. John.

Section 2. That all claims submitted for materials, services, and/or labor which are not payable from a line item of the budget established by the St. John Sanitary District shall be paid from the funds held by the St. John Municipal Sewer Utility.

Section 3. That upon exhaustion of funds available for payment of claims from the operating budget and tax levy established by the Sanitary District of the Town of St. John, all further claims submitted for materials, services, and/or labor

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shall be paid from the funds held by the St. John Municipal Sewer Utility.

Section 4. That the Board of Sanitary Commissioners of the Town of St. John and the Town Council of the Town of St. John may, by agreement, allocate any individual claim to either the accounts of the St. John Sanitary District or the accounts of the St. John Municipal Sewer Utility.
