ordinance no. 897

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 511, BEING: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC, AND ESTABLISHING FINES AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS IN THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA . . . " AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES, OR PARTS THEREOF, IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has reviewed the regulations, General Provisions and Traffic Rules contained in the Town Code; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has been advised that amendment is required to the Town Code and the provisions of Town Ordinance No. 511, pertaining to designated intersections in the Town at which vehicles are required to stop at one or more entrances to such intersections; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has determined that it is necessary and advisable to amend the Town Code, as amended by the provisions of Town Ordinance No. 511 pertaining to designated intersections in the Town at which vehicles are required to stop at one or more entrances to such intersections; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has further determined that in order to promote the public health, safety, comfort, morals, convenience and general welfare and well-being of the residents of the Town, it is necessary, advisable and in the best interests of the residents of the Town to amend the Town Code in its terms pertaining to designated intersections in the Town at which vehicles shall be required to stop at one (1) or more entrances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION ONE: That Schedule 1, referenced in the Section entitled Stop Signs, of ARTICLE XI of Ordinance No. 511, as amended from time to time, entitled THROUGH STREETS, be, and the same is hereby amended to add the following streets and intersections where Stop Signs have been placed and located, namely:

School Street and Wicker Avenue 93rd Avenue and Keilman Street 95th Avenue and Keilman Street SECTION TWO: That all existing Ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby deemed null, void, and of no legal effect, and are specifically repealed.

<u>SECTION THREE:</u> If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion of this Ordinance.

SECTION FOUR: That this Ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force and effect, from and after its passage by the Town Council of the Town of St. John.
