

TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA

ORDINANCE NO. 954

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TOWN ORDINANCE NUMBER 938, BEING: AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SCHEDULE OF WAGES AND SALARIES FOR THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA, FOR THE TOWN EMPLOYEES, FIRE AND POLICE PERSONNEL AND TOWN OFFICIALS, AND ALL AMENDMENTS THERETO, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, did, on the 15th day of November, 1993, pass Ordinance No. 938, thereby establishing the jobs and salaries to be paid certain offices, positions, and jobs with the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has reviewed the terms and provisions of Town Ordinance No. 938, and all amendments passed subsequent thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of ST. John, Lake County, Indiana, has particularly reviewed the terms and provisions of Town Ordinance No. 938, and all amendments passed subsequent thereto regarding the Administrative Assistant/Zoning Administrator's compensation and the compensation of the Fire Chief, Assistant Fire Chief, Firemen and Firemen Training; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has determined after its review of the terms and provisions of Town Ordinance No. 938, and all amendments passed subsequent thereof, that the provisions of said ordinance pertaining to the Administrative Assistant/Zoning Administrator's compensation and the compensation of the Fire Chief, Assistant Fire Chief, Firemen, and Firemen Training.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA:

SECTION ONE: That the specified compensation for the Administrative Assistant/Zoning Administrator, within the following section of Town Salary Ordinance No. 938 and all amendments passed subsequent thereto, entitled "Administrative Assistant/Zoning Administrator Assistant", be, and the same are hereby amended as follows, namely:

"H. Administrative Assistant/  
Zoning Administrator Not to exceed \$1,210.16 bi-weekly from the General Fund. An additional benefit shall be the use of an official vehicle of the town for the undertaking of the duties of the position."

SECTION TWO: That the specified compensation for the Fire Chief, Assistant Fire Chief, Firemen and Firemen Training, within the following section of Town Salary Ordinance No. 938 and all amendments passed subsequent thereto, entitled "Fire Chief, Assistant Fire Chief, Firemen and Firemen Training", be, and the same are hereby amended as follows, namely:

"N. Fire Chief Not to exceed \$11.00 for each call or run within the corporate limits of the Town of St. John, not to exceed \$10.00 for each call or run within the area under contract with the St. John Township Trustee, payable bi-annually from the General Fund (June 17 and December 16, 1994).

Assistant Fire Chief

Not to exceed \$10.00 for each call or run within the corporate limits of the Town of St. John, not to exceed \$9.00 for each call or run within the area under contract with the St. John Township Trustee, payable bi-annually from the General Fund (June 17 and December 16, 1994).

Firemen

Not to exceed \$9.00 for each call or run within the corporate limits of the Town of St. John, not to exceed \$9.00 for each call or run within the area under contract with the St. John Township Trustee, payable bi-annually from the General Fund (June 17 and December 16, 1994).

Firemen Training

Not to exceed \$10.00 for each practice session attended payable bi-annually from the General Fund (June 17 and December 16, 1994)."

SECTION TWO: That all remaining terms and provisions of Town Salary Ordinance No. 938, and all amendments passed subsequent thereto, not inconsistent with the terms and provisions of the within Ordinance, are hereby reaffirmed and ratified.

SECTION THREE: That all existing Ordinances, Guidelines, Regulations or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby deemed null, void, and of no legal effect, and are specifically repealed.



SECTION FIVE: That this Ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force and effect, from and after its passage by the Town council of the Town of St. John.


