

TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA
ORDINANCE NO. 999

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13 OF THE TOWN CODE REGARDING MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, PERTAINING TO TRAFFIC SCHEDULES, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES, OR PARTS THEREOF, IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has reviewed the Regulations, General Provisions and Traffic Rules contained in Chapter 13 of the Town Code; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has been advised that amendment is required to the Town Code and the provisions of Chapter 13 regarding Motor Vehicles and Traffic, pertaining to Traffic Schedules designating intersections in the Town at which vehicles are required to stop at One (1) or more entrances to such intersections; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has determined that it is necessary and advisable to amend the Town Code, and particularly the provisions of Chapter 13 regarding Motor Vehicles and Traffic Schedules designating intersections in the Town at which vehicles are required to stop at One (1) or more entrances to such intersections; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has further determined that in order to promote the public health, safety, comfort, morals, convenience and general welfare and well-being of the residents of the Town, it is necessary, advisable and in the best interest of the residents of the Town to amend the Town Code in its terms under Chapter 13 pertaining to designated intersections in Town at which vehicles shall be required to stop at One (1) or more entrances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION ONE: That Schedule 7, entitled "stop streets", of ARTICLE XXI, entitled "TRAFFIC SCHEDULES", of Chapter 13 of the Town Code, entitled "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", be, and the same is hereby amended to add the following street and intersection where Stop Signs shall be placed and located, namely:

Northbound White Oak Avenue at 101st Avenue.

SECTION TWO: That all existing Ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provision of this Ordinance, are hereby deemed null, void, and of no legal effect, and are specifically repealed.

SECTION THREE: If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion of this Ordinance.

SECTION FOUR: That this Ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force and effect, from and after its passage by the Town Council of the Town of St. John.
