

TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA

ORDINANCE NO. 1058

BEING AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 511, AND ALL AMENDMENTS THERETO, THE SAME BEING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC, AND ESTABLISHING FINES AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS IN THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA, AND REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, on the 9th day of April, 1979, passed and adopted Ordinance No. 511, the same being an ordinance regulating traffic, and establishing fines and penalties for violations of traffic regulations in the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing Ordinance has been amended on numerous occasions in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Town of St. John; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to amend such ordinance again, to add to the list of 20-mile per hour speed zones three (3) streets within the Town limits of the Town of St. John; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has come to the conclusion that Ordinance No. 511, as amended, should be amended and the following streets should be added to Sec. 13-1009, the same being Schedule 9, as 20-mile per hour speed zones, namely, Heron Lake Road, Knickerbocker Place, and Monfort Drive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana that Ordinance No. 511 shall be amended as follows, to-wit:

Sec. 13-1009. Schedule 9, 20-mile per hour speed zones.

ADD TO (b) The following are zones in which the maximum speed limit is twenty (20) miles per hour:

Heron Lake Road
Knickerbocker Place
Monfort Drive.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the remainder of Ordinance No. 511, as amended, when not in conflict herewith shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that if any section, clause, provision, or portion of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion of this ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect, from and after its passage by the Town Council of the Town of St. John.
