TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA

ORDINANCE NO. _1065

BEING AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 511, AND ALL AMENDMENTS THERETO, THE SAME BEING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC, AND ESTABLISHING FINES AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS IN THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, on the 9th day of April, 1979, passed and adopted Ordinance No. 511, the same being an ordinance regulating traffic, and establishing fines and penalties for violations of traffic regulations in the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing Ordinance has been amended on numerous occasions in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Town of St. John; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has received complaints from residents living near West 102nd Avenue and 105th Avenue, to the extent that new stop signs should be added at the intersection of West 102nd Avenue at Delmar and 105th Avenue at S. Magoun Drive; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has come to the conclusion that Ordinance No. 511 should be amended and stop signs should be added at the intersections aforesaid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana that Ordinance No. 511 shall be amended as follows, to-wit:

Sec. 13-1014. Schedule 14, three-way stops

ADD TO (b) West 102nd Avenue at Delmar 105th Avenue at S. Magoun Drive.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Police Department is authorized to place a yellow flasher on the stop signs for no less than thirty (30) days to alert motorists of the new stop signs.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the remainder of Ordinance No. 511 when not in conflict herewith shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that if any section, clause, provision, or portion of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion of this ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect, from and after its passage by the Town Council of the Town of St. John.
