

TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA

ORDINANCE NO. 1076

BEING AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1062, THE SAME BEING AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF WAGES AND SALARIES FOR EMPLOYEES, FIRE AND POLICE PERSONNEL, AND TOWN OFFICIALS FOR THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, did, on the 30th day of December, 1997, adopt Ordinance No. 1062, the same being an ordinance establishing a schedule of wages and salaries for employees, fire and police personnel, and town officials for the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has determined that it is necessary to amend such ordinance with the addition of Public Works Employee Class V-A and Clerk-Treasurer's Employee IV.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, that the following schedule of wages and salaries and dates of payment therefor shall be amended as follows, to wit:

| B. | Public Works Employee<br>Class V-A, Full-Time      | Not to exceed \$226.67, bi-weekly from MVH, Water Utility, and Sewer Utility, for the pay period beginning July 18, 1998 and continuing through pay period ending December 18, 1998.         |
| G. | Clerk-Treasurer's Employees<br>Class IV, Full-Time | Not to exceed \$267.76, bi-weekly from the General Fund, Water Utility, and Sewer Utility, for the pay period beginning August 15, 1998 and continuing through pay period December 18, 1998. |


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances, or parts of ordinances, policies, or parts of policies, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed and declared to be null, void, and of no legal affect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that if any section, clause provision, or portion of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion of this ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that ~~the~~ an emergency exists for the immediate taking effect of this ordinance therefore, this ordinance is hereby passed and adopted by the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, and shall be become effective this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of July, 1998.
