

TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA

ORDINANCE NO. 1165

AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING AND DISSOLVING THE ST.  
JOHN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT STEERING COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, on December 10, 1984, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, did pass Ordinance No. 653; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing Ordinance No. 653 was an Ordinance officially establishing the St. John Economic Development Steering Committee, and setting forth the responsibilities of the Committee, its membership, and the terms of office of its members; and

WHEREAS, the purpose for establishing the St. John Economic Development Steering Committee was to qualify the Town of St. John as a participant in the Indiana Department of Commerce registered cities and towns program; and

WHEREAS, the Indiana Department of Commerce registered cities and towns program no longer exists and therefore there is no reason for the St. John Economic Development Steering Committee to continue its existence; and

WHEREAS, the St. John Economic Development Steering Committee has not met for several years and currently serves no useful purpose; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the inactivity of the St. John Economic Development Steering Committee and of the interest of the present St. John Town Council to create a new Committee for the purpose of promoting development in the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, the St. John Town Council hereby finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, that the St. John Economic Development Steering Committee be abolished and eliminated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, hereby finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, that the St. John Economic Development Steering Committee be dissolved and abolished and therefore the same is hereby dissolved, abolished, and eliminated.

SECTION TWO: All terms and provisions of Ordinance No. 653, as well as all other existing ordinances or regulations, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby deemed null, void, and of no legal affect and are

specifically repealed.

SECTION THREE: If any section, clause, provision, or portion of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion of this ordinance.


SECTION FOUR: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Town Council pursuant to law.
