ORDINANCE NO. 1253

BEING AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 511, AND ALL AMENDMENTS THERETO, THE SAME BEING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC, AND ESTABLISHING FINES AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS IN THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, on the 9th day of April, 1979, passed and adopted Ordinance No. 511, the same being an ordinance regulating traffic, and establishing fines and penalties for violations of traffic regulations in the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing Ordinance has been amended on numerous occasions in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Town of St. John; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has received a request from the St. John Public Works Department and the Chief of the Police Department to approve five (5) new stop signs and one (1) speed limit sign indicating a 20 mile per hour speed zone, in Sierra Pointe – Unit II, as set forth below; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has come to the conclusion that Ordinance No. 511 should be amended and that five (5) new stop signs and one (1) 20 mile per hour speed limit sign, should be added as set forth and at the location below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana that Ordinance No. 511 shall be amended as follows, to-wit:

Section 13-1007	Schedule 7, Stop Streets
ADD TO (b)	West 92 nd Lane at Mallard Lane West 92 nd Avenue at Mallard Lane West 92 nd Avenue at Drake Drive West 92nd Lane at Drake Drive West 91 st Place at Marquette Street
Section 13-1009	Schedule 9, 20 Mile Per Hour Speed Zones
ADD TO (b)	West 91 st Place – eastbound (entrance into Sierra Pointe)

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the remainder of Ordinance No. 511 when not in conflict herewith shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that if any section, clause, provision, or portion of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion of this Ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER ORAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect, from and after its passage by the Town Council of the Town of St. John.
