## TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA

## **ORDINANCE NO. 1266**

BEING AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 511, AND ALL AMENDMENTS THERETO, THE SAME BEING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC, AND ESTABLISHING FINES AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS IN THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1979, passed and adopted Ordinance No. 511, the same being an ordinance regulating traffic, and establishing fines and penalties for violations of traffic regulations in the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing Ordinance has been amended on numerous occasions in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Town of St. John; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has received a request from the St. John Public Works Department and the Chief of the Police Department to approve one (1) new stop sign in Sun Meadows – Unit III, as set forth below; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has come to the conclusion that Ordinance No. 511 should be amended and that one (1) stop sign should be added as set forth and at the location below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana that Ordinance No. 511 shall be amended as follows, to-wit:

Section 13-1007	Schedule 7, Stop Streets
ADD TO (b)	(Sun Meadows – Unit III) Schillton Drive at Snowberry Lane - northbound
Section 13-1008	Schedule 8, Four-Way Stops
ADD TO (b)	(Sun Meadows - Unit III) Schillton Drive & Snowberry Lane - northbound Schillton Drive & Snowberry Lane - southbound Snowberry Lane & Schillton Drive - eastbound Snowberry Lane & Schillton Drive - westbound

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the remainder of Ordinance No. 511 when not in conflict herewith shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that if any section, clause, provision, or portion of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion of this Ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER ORAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect, from and after its passage by the Town Council of the Town of St. John.
