

TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA

ORDINANCE NO. 1282

BEING AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 511, AND ALL AMENDMENTS THERETO, THE SAME BEING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC, AND ESTABLISHING FINES AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS IN THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, on the 9th day of April, 1979, passed and adopted Ordinance No. 511, the same being an ordinance regulating traffic, and establishing fines and penalties for violations of traffic regulations in the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing Ordinance has been amended on numerous occasions in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Town of St. John; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests in the Town of St. John to amend Ordinance No. 511, to provide for the foregoing changes in Ordinance No. 511, as amended, and more specifically ARTICLE XV designated "PENALTIES AND PROCEDURE ON ARREST" thereof, and more particularly, Subsection 7. "Disposition of Traffic Fines and Forfeitures", accordingly.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, that the Town of St. John Ordinance No. 511, as amended, and more specifically ARTICLE XV designated "PENALTIES AND PROCEDURE ON ARREST" thereof, and more particularly, Subsection 7., designated "Disposition Of Traffic Fines And Forfeitures", shall read and state as follows:

Disposition of Traffic Fines and Forfeitures. 7. In accordance with I.C. 9-4-1-125 and I.C. 34-4-32-1 any person, firm or corporation violating and found liable by plea of any portion of this traffic...

Such penalties shall be paid within fourteen (14) days of the date of the violation. Upon failure to pay any penalty herein prescribed in accordance with the provisions hereof, such violator shall be charged forthwith in a court pursuant to Indiana Law. All moving violations of the ordinance shall be certified pursuant to Indiana Law...

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the remainder of Ordinance No. 511 when not in conflict herewith shall remain in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that if any section, clause, provision, or portion of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion of this Ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER ORAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect, from and after its passage by the Town Council of the Town of St. John.
