

TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA

ORDINANCE NO. 1332

BEING AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1318, THE SAME BEING AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF WAGES AND SALARIES FOR EMPLOYEES, FIRE AND POLICE PERSONNEL, AND TOWN OFFICIALS FOR THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, did, on the 20th day of November, 2003, adopt Ordinance No. 1318, the same being an ordinance establishing a schedule of wages and salaries for employees, fire and police personnel, and town officials for the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, now finds it in the best interests of the town, to amend said Ordinance No. 1318, creating a schedule of wages and salaries and dates of payment for the employees of said St. John Fire Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana that the following schedule of wages and salaries and dates of payment therefore for the following shall become effective immediately and continuing through pay period ending December 31, 2004, shall be amended as follows, to-wit:

E. FIRE DEPARTMENT

Assistant Fire Chief

Not to exceed \$15.00 per call or run respond to within the corporate limits of the Town of St. John and within the area under contract with the St. John Township Trustees Office or by mutual aid agreement, payable bi-annually from the General Fund (June 18 and December 17, 2004).

Firefighter

Not to exceed \$10.00 per call or run respond to within the corporate limits of the Town of St. John and within the area under contract with the St. John Township Trustees Office or by mutual aid agreement, payable bi-annually from the General Fund (June 18 and December 17, 2004).

**Records / Billing Clerk
(Full or Part-Time)**

Not to exceed \$10.00 per hour, paid bi-weekly from the General Fund.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances, or parts of ordinances, policies, or parts of policies, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed and declared to be null, void, and of no legal affect.



BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that an emergency exists for the immediate taking effect of this ordinance therefore, this ordinance is hereby passed and adopted by the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, and shall become effective this 29th day of January, 2004, by a vote of 5 in Favor and 0 Against.


