

TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA

ORDINANCE NO. 1490

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 1478, BEING AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF WAGES AND SALARIES FOR EMPLOYEES, FIRE AND POLICE PERSONNEL, AND TOWN OFFICIALS FOR THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA, AND ALL MATTERS RELATED HERETO.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, did, on the 24th day of November, 2008, adopt Town Salary Ordinance No. 1478, the same being an Ordinance establishing a schedule of wages and salaries for employees, fire and police personnel, and Town officials for the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, now finds it in the best interests of the Town to amend said Town Salary Ordinance No. 1478 creating a schedule of wages and salaries and dates of payment for employees of various departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: That the following schedule of wages and salaries and dates of payment therefore, for Department Personnel listed below, and as hereby established, be and is hereby amended, to commence with the pay period beginning April 11, 2009, and continuing through the pay period ending December 18, 2009, namely:

A. TOWN COUNCIL EMPLOYEES

Computer Network Administrator
(exempt)


Not to exceed \$2,115.38, paid bi-weekly from the General Fund, Waterworks District, and Sanitary District, in whole or in part.
(2 weeks vacation are included, with all other benefits provided all other Town exempt salaried employees.)


SECTION TWO: That all Ordinances, and Town Code Sections and provisions, or portions thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed and declared to be null, void, and of no legal affect.

SECTION THREE: That if any section, clause, provision, or portion of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion of this Ordinance.

SECTION FOUR: That this Ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force and effect, from and after its passage and adoption by the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, and shall become effective this 23rd day of April, 2009.




