ORDINANCE NO.: 1536

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TOWN SALARY ORDINANCE NO. 1529 ESTABLISHING A SCHEDULE OF WAGES AND SALARIES FOR EMPLOYEES, FIRE AND POLICE PERSONNEL, AND TOWN OFFICIALS OF THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA, FOR 2011, AND REPEALING ALL TOWN ORDINANCES, OR PARTS THEREOF, IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.**

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has reviewed Town Ordinance No.: 1529 establishing jobs and salaries to be paid to certain offices, positions and jobs within the Town of St. John for the year 2011 (hereinafter referred to as the "2011 Town Salary Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has been advised that the provisions of the 2011 Town Salary Ordinance pertaining to compensation for the Town Animal Control Officer have been reviewed, and require amendment consistent with current circumstances for the Town job employment position of Animal Control Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, now deems it appropriate, advisable and in the best interests of the residents of the Town of St. John, that the provisions of the 2011 Town Salary Ordinance pertaining to compensation for the Town Animal Control Officer be amended for Year 2011 consistent with current circumstances in the Town for the job employment position.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION ONE:** That the salary for the Town job employment position of **Animal Control Officer I**, provided for in the Section entitled **POLICE DEPARTMENTEMPLOYEES**, in Town Ordinance No.: 1529, as amended from time to time, shall be amended to read, and provide hereafter, as follows:

**"TOWN POLICE DEPARTMENT:**

Animal Control Officer I, Full Time or	Not to exceed \$16.00 per hour, bi-weekly
Part Time	from the General Fund"

**SECTION TWO:** That the Animal Control Officer's compensation, as set forth in **SECTION ONE** of this amendatory 2011 Salary Ordinance, shall be effective upon adoption, and the Town Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to pay the Animal Control Officer at the rate set forth hereinabove upon written directions from the Town Manager.

**SECTION THREE:** That all existing Ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby deemed null, void, and of no legal effect, and are specifically repealed.

**SECTION FOUR:** If any section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other section, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance.

**SECTION FIVE:** That this Ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force and effect, from and after its passage and adoption by the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, in conformance with applicable law.


