ORDINANCE NO: 1773

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING FUND 8853, ENTITLED
ESCROW CLEARING/REIMBURSEMENT FUND, DORMANT AND
AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF SURPLUS PROCEEDS TO THE
TOWN OF ST. JOHN GENERAL FUND

WHEREAS, the Clerk-Treasurer of the Town of St. John has recently advised the members of the Town Council that Fund 8853, entitled Escrow/Clearing Reimbursement Fund has been dormant for a period of years ant that the original intent of the fund has been exhausted and abandoned; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John has reviewed the information received from the Clerk-Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John has determined that it is in the best interests of the citizens of St. John that Fund 8853 be determined to be dormant and exhausted and that any proceeds remaining in Fund 8853 shall be transferred to the General Account of the Town of St. John.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION ONE. Fund 8853 entitled Escrow/Clearing Reimbursement Fund is hereby declared as a dormant fund, and, pursuant to law, the Clerk Treasurer shall transfer the remaining proceeds in that fund to the Town of St. John General Fund.

SECTION TWO. That this Ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force and effect, from and after its passage by the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana.
