

RESOLUTION 10-14-85

TOWN OF ST. JOHN

BE It RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of St. John,
Indiana:

1. That a complete set of drawings, plans, and specifications for a system of street lights not owned by but located along the streets and roadways within the corporate limits of the Town of St. John, as well as an estimate of the annual cost of the street lighting is on file in its office, or with the municipal clerk if it has no office.

2. That the Clerk of said Town published a notice stating that a public hearing would be held in regard to the construction, erection, installation, maintenance and/or operation of a system of street lights not owned by but located along the streets and roadways within the corporate limits of the Town of St. John and that interested persons could file remonstrances against the lighting system at the hearing, and that said hearing was held on the 14th day of October, 1985.

3. The Board finds that the sytem of street lights will benefit the public.

4. That the cost of operating and maintaining said lighting system will be paid by the City from its General Fund and from funds set aside for street lighting purposes.

5. That Northern Indiana Public Service Company is the exclusive supplier of electricity to the municipality and has the right to serve the electric system.


6. The declaratory resolution adopted on the 14th day of October, 1985, is hereby confirmed except to the extent as modified herein.

7. That energy will be furnished per lamp per year for the following schedule of services and for such additional lamps as may be installed in the future:
