

RESOLUTION 121178

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE REDUCTION OF THE 1978 APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING FUND OF THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, did by Ordinance Number 8/29/77 H appropriate an amount of Twenty-Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$24,500.00), in the 1978 Federal Revenue Sharing Fund annual bidget, and

WHEREAS, the State Board of Tax Commissioners did subsequently fix the 1978 Federal Revenue Sharing Fund budget appropriation at Fifteen Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-seven Dollars (\$15,467.00), and

WHEREAS, The State Board of Tax Commissioners did order the Board of Trustees to reduce the 1978 Federal REvenue sharing fund appropriation in the amount of Nine Thousand Thirty-three Dollars (\$9,033.00), and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary that the Board of Trustees must amend the 1978 Federal Revenue sharing fund ordinance of appropriations in such manner that the expenditures of the ensuing year remain within the limitations which are ordered by the State Board of Tax Commissioners.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, that the following appropriations be reduced in the following amounts:
