RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE WATER FUND ACCOUNT TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN

Whereas, the Board of Trustees of the Town of St.

John, Lake County, Indiana, does now find that an emergency exists and that in order to operate and maintain the governmental functions of the said Town it is necessary to temporarily transfer funds from the Water Fund Account to the General Fund Account of the 175

Town of St. John for a period of 20 days from this date; and

Whereas, there is sufficient money on deposit to the credit of the Water Fund of the said Town of St. John which can be temporarily advanced;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of St. John, that a temporary transfer of funds be made as follows:

The sum of Five Thousand and no/100 (\$5,000.00) Dollars from the Water Fund Account to the General Fund of the Town of St. John for a period of 120 days.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk-Treasurer make appropriate entries on the books of record and account of said Water Fund and the General Fund to indicate said temporary transfer.
