RESOLUTION NO. 2-28-94

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ENTRY INTO AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE TOWNS OF DYER, SCHERERVILLE AND ST. JOHN FOR ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES FOR CALENDAR YEAR 1994.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has reviewed the needs and requirements of the Town for animal control services within the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has, for a number of years, entered into a joint agreement with the Towns of Dyer and Schererville to provide animal control services to the residents of the Three (3) Towns; and

WHEREAS, the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, is a Municipal Corporation empowered by the terms and provisions of Indiana Code 36-1-7-1, et. seq., as amended from time to time, to enter into agreements with participating governmental units so as to better provide public services and facilities to the residents of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Towns of Dyer and Schererville, located in Lake County, Indiana, are also Municipal Corporations empowered by the terms and provisions of Indiana Code 36-1-7-1, et. seq., as amended from time to time, to enter into agreements with other local governmental units for the purposes of better providing public services and facilities for the mutual benefit of the participating governmental units; and

WHEREAS, the Towns of Dyer, Schererville and St. John each seek to enter into a Joint Interlocal Cooperation Agreement based upon the provisions and requirements of Indiana Code 36-1-7-1, et. seq., as amended from time to time, together, to provide for animal control services for each of the Three (3) Towns for the mutual benefit of the participating Towns, at shared costs; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has determined that entry into a Joint Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with the Towns of Dyer and Schererville for the purposes of providing animal control services for the Three (3) participating Towns is in the best interests of the residents of the Town of St. John, and therefore, has determined that it is advisable to enter into such a Joint Interlocal Cooperation Agreement pursuant to the applicable provisions of State Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN, LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA:

SECTION ONE: That the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, shall take all appropriate and legal measures to enter into a joint interlocal

cooperation agreement with the Towns of Dyer and Schererville to provide animal control services for the mutual benefit of the Three (3) participating Towns, at shared costs.


SECTION TWO: That the President of the Town Council is hereby authorized and permitted to enter into a joint interlocal cooperation agreement for the providing of animal control services for the mutual benefit of the Towns of Dyer, Schererville and St. John, at shared costs, pursuant to the applicable provisions of Indiana Code 36-1-7-1, et. seq., as amended from time to time; further, the Town Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized to attest the execution of said agreement by the President of the Town Council.

SECTION THREE: That a copy of the joint interlocal cooperation agreement between the Towns of Dyer, Schererville and St. John for animal control services for calendar year 1994 shall be attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein by reference.


SECTION FOUR: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana.
