

RESOLUTION NO. 3-10-69

WHEREAS, the Water Department of the Town of St. John, from time to time is unable to have its employees read meters by reason of inability to contact its customers, or inclement weather, and

WHEREAS, it has been the usual practice to send an estimated charge until such meter of the customers were read, and

WHEREAS, the use of an estimated bill is not a satisfactory procedure and it would be in the best interest of the customers of the Water Department of the Town of St. John, that a minimum charge be utilized.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, as follows:

That when the employees of the Water Department are unable to read a customer's meter at the time of the normal visit of such employee, a minimum charge of \$3.25 per month shall be taxed against the customer until the proper meter reading and cost can be established by the Water Department.
