TOWN OF ST. JOHN


WHEREAS, the 1971 General Assembly passed the Home Rule Act which attempted to broaden the range of alternative solutions available for cities to address their problems; and

WHEREAS, the Home Rule Act did not include towns; and

WHEREAS, St. John and other towns face the same complex problems only on a smaller scale as larger cities do;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Trustees of the Town of St. John urge the 1977 General Assembly to pass House Bill 1829 which along with other provisions includes towns under the purview of the Home Rule Act.
