RESOLUTION INDICATING SUPPORT FOR THE PRINCIPLES AND FEATURES OF THE RECOMMENDED SHORT RANGE SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL PLAN FOR NORTHWESTERN INDIANA.

WHEREAS, the disposal of solid waste is a major problem for municipal government in northwestern Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the federal and state governments are increasing their requirements and standards for environmental protection and other aspects of solid waste disposal; and

WHEREAS, solid waste disposal in the future will become more difficult and more costly if planning to make best use of available resources is not carried out at the present time; and

WHEREAS, the Northwestern Indiana Regional Planning Commission has prepared a short range solid waste disposal plan which addresses the problems of solid waste disposal for the next 15 years and provides a base upon which to build for the future; and

WHEREAS, the support of the Regional Planning Commission's Recommended Short Range Solid Waste Disposal Plan by local governments in Lake and Porter Counties will help assure local control over this important local government function:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana hereby indicates its support of both the general provisions and the specific provisions of the Recommended Short Range Disposal Plan for Northwestern Indiana.
