

RESOLUTION NO. S-13-91A

WHEREAS, the Indiana Criminal Justice Institute is the state agency charged with the responsibility for the distribution of funds recovered in certain seizures of monies involving serious drug related offenses; and

WHEREAS, the Indiana Criminal Justice Institute has established certain criteria for the distribution of overtime funds to various local police agencies for their efforts in assisting in the apprehension and arrest of those perpetrating said drug-related crimes; and

WHEREAS, the appropriate agency for the receipt and distribution of said overtime funds in Lake County is the Lake County Drug Task Force, the Executive Committee of which shall authorize the expenditure of such funds; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the St. John Police Department, and its designated members, to participate in this program, designated as Lake County Drug Task Force Grant Number 90 DB 038; and

WHEREAS, it is also in the best interests of the citizens of our community that our police officers participate in this program on a cooperative basis with all other agencies in Lake County for the betterment of all of the citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the St. John that it hereby authorizes its police officers to participate in activities pursuant to Lake County Drug Task Force Grant Number 90 DB 038, including the working of overtime hours associated therewith, and further, directs the Clerk-Treasurer to establish a separate fund for receipt of monies distributed by the Lake County Drug Task Force for overtime hours worked by our police officers pursuant to said grant.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Police Department shall be responsible for the keeping and maintaining of accurate records substantiating overtime hours worked pursuant to the grant, pursuant to directions obtained from the Lake County Drug Task Force.
