

RESOLUTION NO. 81274 A

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE
FLOOD INSURANCE PROGRAM IN THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN,
LAKE COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, certain areas of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, have been identified by the Federal Insurance Administration as having special flood hazards which may cause serious damage to properties within these areas, and

WHEREAS, relief is available in the form of Federal Subsidized flood insurance as authorized by the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Board of Trustees of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, to require the evaluation of special hazards relating to land use in those areas identified by the Federal Insurance Administration as having special flood hazards; and

WHEREAS, the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, must adopt land use and control measures in accordance with the National Flood Insurance Program and Title 42, Section 4001 through and including Section 4127 of United States Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, as follows:

1. That the Board of Trustees of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, assures the Federal Insurance Administration that it will enact as necessary and maintain in force for those areas identified by the Federal Insurance Administration as special flood hazard areas, adequate land use and control measures in accordance with the criteria set forth in Section 1910 of the National Flood Insurance Program regulations.

2. That the Board of Trustees of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, will:

a. assist the administration of the Federal Flood Insurance Program, at his request in delineating the areas having special flood hazards on local maps of sufficient scale to identify the location of building sites.

b. provide such information as the administrator of the National Flood Insurance Program may require concerning present uses and occupancy of the areas identified as having special flood hazards.

c. cooperate with Federal and State Agencies pursuant to the Federal Flood Insurance Program and Title 42, Section 4001 through Section 4127 to study, survey, map and identify special flood hazard areas as may be required by the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended.

d. submit on the anniversary date of the Town of St. John's initial eligibility, a report to the administrator on the status of flood plain management measures.

3. That the Board of Trustees of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, hereby appoints the Clerk-Treasurer of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, upon the termination and receipt from the Federal Flood Insurance Administration or the Indiana Department of Natural Resources for public inspections and to furnish upon request, a record of elevations in relation to mean sea level of the lowest floor, including basement, of all new or substantially improved structures located in special flood hazard areas as identified by the Federal Insurance Administrator.

4. That the Board of Trustees of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, agrees to take such other official action as may be required of it by the Federal Insurance Administration to carry out the objectives of the National Flood Insurance

Program as set forth by the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended.
