A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE EFFORTS OF
CONCERNED CITIZENS OF THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN
TO HAVE CONDUCTED A ZIP CODE BOUNDARY REVIEW
PROCESS BY THE U.S. POSTAL SERVICE

WHEREAS, The Town of St. John, based upon information obtained by an ad hoc citizens group, has two separate zip code designations; and


WHEREAS, these separate zip code designations have caused considerable confusion and inconvenience to both the residents of the Town and to the U.S. Postal Service; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Town Council of St. John believe it would be in the best interests of the citizens of the Town, and in the best interests of efficiency and economy in the delivery and distribution of mail by the U.S. Postal Service that a uniform zip code be established for the Town; and


WHEREAS, the U.S. Postal Service provides a Zip Code Boundary Review Process to determine and decide these issues of proper boundary locations and designations for the delivery and distribution of mail;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Town Council of St. John that they strongly endorse the initiation of a Zip Code Boundary Review Process by the U.S. Postal Service with the ultimate result being the establishment of a uniform zip code for the entire Town of St. John.
