PETITION OF THE TOWN OF ST. JOHN  
FOR TAX RELIEF FROM PROPERTY TAX LEVY LIMITATIONS


WHEREAS, the Town of St. John, Indiana will be unable to carry out, in the ensuing budget year, the governmental functions and responsibilities committed to it by law without tax relief; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to the procedures provided in IC 6-1.1-17-15 and IC 6-1.1-18.5-12, it is necessary for the Town of St. John to petition for relief from the limitations imposed by IC 6-1.1-18.5-12; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that said petition be filed before the State Board of Tax Commissioners to obtain such relief.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana that an appeal be executed by the President of the Council authorizing all actions to perfect such appeal.
