

CONFIRMING RESOLUTION SD-2

WHEREAS, the Board of Sanitary Commissioners of the Sanitary District of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has heretofore determined by its Declaratory Resolution adopted on August 14, 1984, that it is necessary for the public health and welfare and will be of public utility and benefit to construct and install interceptor sewers, more particularly described in said Declaratory Resolution, within said Sanitary District; and

WHEREAS, said Board further determined by its said Declaratory Resolution adopted August 14, 1984, that it will be necessary to acquire, by purchase or appropriation, certain lands, easements and rights-of-way along the routes of said sewers, which lands, easements and rights-of-way are more particularly described in said Declaratory Resolution for use in connection with said improvements;




