

CONFIRMING RESOLUTION SD 4-1-93

WHEREAS, the Board of Sanitary Commissioners of the Sanitary District of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, has heretofore determined by its Declaratory Resolution adopted on March 4, 1993, that it is necessary for the public health and welfare and will be of public utility and benefit to purchase additional treatment capacity at the Schererville Wastewater Treatment Plant all in accordance with the agreement dated May 14, 1990; that in connection with said purchase there shall be a refunding of the 1985 General Obligation bond; and a refunding of the existing contractual payments for capacity pursuant to the May 14, 1990 agreement, more particularly described in said Declaratory Resolution, within said Sanitary District; and


WHEREAS, notice of the hearing on said Declaratory Resolution has been published in the manner required by law and like notice has been mailed to the owners of all lands to be purchased or appropriated under and by said resolution, and thereafter on April 1, 1993, being the time and place fixed in said notice for said hearing, did hear all persons desiring to be heard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Sanitary Commissioners of the Sanitary District of the Town of St. John, Lake County, Indiana, that the Declaratory Resolution adopted by this Board on March 4, 1993, be and the same is hereby confirmed, and the projects described in said Declaratory Resolution be and the same is hereby declared to be of public utility and benefit to

the Sanitary District of the Town of St. John, Lake County,
Indiana.


